Preface:

- Change Attribute Set is perfect extension for the store owners who wants to easily change the already created products attribute set.
- In Magento every product has a fixed attribute set that cannot be changed after the product's creation. This module enables you to switch it.
- Auto assign configurable products attribute in selected attribute set if not.



Installation:

There are two ways of installing extension in magento2.

Using COMMAND LINE.
Manually install extension.

Option 1: Magento 2 install extension using COMMAND LINE (Recommended).

Follow below steps to install extension from the command line.

- Step 1: Download the extension and unzip it.
- **Step 2:** Upload it to code directory in your magento installation's app directory. If code directory does not exists then create.
- **Step 3:** Disable the cache under System \rightarrow Cache Management.
- Step 4: Enter the following at the command line: php bin/magento setup:upgrade php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
- Step 5: Once you complete above steps log out and log in back to the admin panel and switch to Stores → Configuration → Mageants → Change attribute set, The module will be displayed in the admin panel.



- Option 2: Magento 2 install extension manually.
- **Step 1:** Download the extension and unzip it.
- **Step 2:** Upload it to code directory in your magento installation's app directory. If code directory does not exists then create.
- Step 3: Disable the cache under System → Cache Management Edit app/etc/config.php file and add one line code: 'Mageants_Changeattributeset' → 1
- **Step 4:** Disable the cache under System \rightarrow Cache Management
- Step 5: Once you complete above steps log out and log in back to the admin panel and switch to Stores → Configuration → Mageants → Change attribute set, the module will be displayed in the admin panel.
