#### **Installation:**

There are two ways of installing extension in magento2.

- 1) Using COMMAND LINE.
- 2) Manually install extension.
- **Option 1:** Magento 2 install extension using COMMAND LINE (Recommended).

Follow below steps to install extension from the command line.


- **Step 1:** Download the extension and unzip it.
- **Step 2:** Upload it to code directory in your magento installation's app directory. If code directory does not exists then create.
- **Step 3:** Disable the cache under System → Cache Management.
- **Step 4:** Enter the following at the command line: php bin/magento setup:upgrade php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
- **Step 5:** Once you complete above steps log out and log in back to the admin panel and switch to Stores → Configuration → Mageants → Contact form . The module will be displayed in the admin panel.



- Option 2: Magento 2 install extension manually.
- **Step 1:** Download the extension and unzip it.
- **Step 2:** Upload it to code directory in your magento installation's app directory. If code directory does not exists then create.
- **Step 3:** Disable the cache under System → Cache Management Edit app/etc/config.php file and add one line code: 'Mageants contactform' → 1
- **Step 4:** Disable the cache under System → Cache Management
- **Step 5:** Once you complete above steps log out and log in back to the admin panel and switch to Stores → Configuration → Mageants → Contact form, the module will be displayed in the admin panel.




