## Preface

## Installation:

There are two ways of installing extension in magento2.

- 1) Using COMMAND LINE.
- 2) Manually install extension.

**Option 1:** Magento 2 install extension using COMMAND LINE (Recommended).

Follow below steps to install extension from the command line.

**Step 1:** Download the extension and unzip it.

**Step 2:** Upload it to code directory in your magento installation's app directory.  
If code directory does not exists then create.

**Step 3:** Disable the cache under System → Cache Management.

**Step 4:** Enter the following at the command line:  
php bin/magento setup:upgrade  
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

**Step 5:** Once you complete above steps log out and log in back to the admin panel and switch to Stores → Configuration → Mageants → Spam and bot blocker. The module will be displayed in the admin panel.

**Option 2:** Magento 2 install extension manually.

**Step 1:** Download the extension and unzip it.

**Step 2:** Upload it to code directory in your magento installation's app directory. If code directory does not exist then create.

**Step 3:** Disable the cache under System → Cache Management Edit app/etc/config.php file and add one line code:  
'Mageants\_Spamandbotblocker' → 1

**Step 4:** Disable the cache under System → Cache Management


**Step 5:** Once you complete above steps log out and log in back to the admin panel and switch to Stores → Configuration → Mageants → Spam and bot blocker, the module will be displayed in the admin panel.






